SIZE

Approx 14 cm, 5½ in

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk
Shade 049 (green) 25 g
Shade 058 (silver grey) 50 g
Shade 001 (white) small amount
Shade 060 (black) small amount
Ricorumi Lamé
Shade 001 (silver)
Ricorumi hook 2.5 mm
Rico eye buttons
Rico embroidery needle
Rico synthetic stuffing
Stitch markers

TENSION

26 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm

HEAD

In silver grey, working into magic ring, 6 dc.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 1: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 2: 12 dc.
Rnd 3: 3 dc, [2 dc in next st] 6 times, 3 dc. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: 3 dc, [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times, 3 dc. 24 sts.
Rnd 5: 24 dc.
Rnd 6: 3 dc, [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times, 3 dc. 30 sts.
Rnd 7: 30 dc.
Rnd 8: 3 dc, [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times, 3 dc. 36 sts.
Rnd 9: 36 dc.
Rnd 10: 3 dc, [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times, 3 dc. 42 sts.
Rnd 11 – 19: 42 dc.
Attach eyes between rnds 12 and 13, 14 sts apart.
Rnd 20: [5 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 36 sts.
Rnd 21: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts.
Fill Head with stuffing.
Rnd 22: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 23: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 24: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Finish filling Head with stuffing.
Rnd 25: [dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.
Thread tail through the last 6 sts, pull tight and weave in.

EAR (MAKE 2)

In silver grey, working into magic ring, 6 dc.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 1: 6 dc.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: 12 dc.
Rnd 4: [1 dc, 2 dc next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnds 5 – 16: 18 dc.
Rnd 17: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 18: 12 dc.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

ARM (MAKE 2)

In silver grey working into magic ring, 6 dc.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnds 1 – 18: 6 dc.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.
Attach Arms to side of Body, directly below Head.

LEG (MAKE 2)

In silver grey working into magic ring, 6 dc.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnds 1 – 3: 6 dc.
Rnd 4: 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 3 dc. 7 sts.
Rnd 5: 7 dc.
Rnd 6: 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 3 dc. 8 sts.
Rnd 7: 8 dc.
Rnd 8: 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 3 dc. 9 sts.
Rnds 9 – 11: 9 dc.
Fill Leg with stuffing.
Fasten off and break yarn for 1st Leg, not for 2nd Leg.

BODY

Rnd 12: In silver grey attach yarn to last st of last rnd of 1st Leg with a sl st, make 4 ch, join with a sl st to last rnd of 2nd Leg, 1 dc in same st as sl st, place marker on this st for beginning of rnd, 8 dc around second Leg, 4 dc along chain, 9 dc around 1st Leg, 4 dc in other side of chain. 26 sts.
Rnd 13: [4 dc, 2 dc in next dc] 2 times, [6 dc, 2 dc in next dc] 2 times, 2 dc. 30 sts. Work another 11 dc to get to the middle of the back. Move marker to new beginning of rnd.
Rnd 14: 7 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 16 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 5 dc. 32 sts.
Rnd 15: 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 16 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 6 dc. 34 sts.
Rnd 16: 15 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 12 dc. 36 sts.
Rnds 17 – 21: 36 dc.
Rnd 22: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnds 23 – 24: 30 dc.
Fill Body with stuffing.
Rnd 25: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 26: 24 dc.
Rnd 27: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 28: 18 sts.
Rnd 29: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 30: BLO, 12 dc.
Finish filling Body with stuffing.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

FRILLY COLLAR

Attach green yarn to top of body, working into the front loops of row 29.
Rnd 1: 2 ch, 2 htr in each of next 12 sts, 1 sl st in top of 2-ch at beginning of rnd = 24 sts.
Rnd 2: 2 ch, 2 htr in each of next 24 sts, 1 sl st in top of 2-ch at beginning of rnd = 48 sts.
Rnd 3: 2 ch, 48 htr, 1 sl st in top of 2-ch at beginning of rnd. Change yarn.
Rnd 4: In silver grey, 2 ch, 48 htr, 1 sl st in top of 2-ch at beginning of rnd.
Fasten off and break yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Use long tails to join the pieces. Fold Ears in half and attach them to the top of the Head between rnds 20 and 21. In white embroider outside of

eyes and in black embroider nose. Attach Head to Body over rnds 15 – 17.
Attach Arms to rnd 29 of Body.

SIZE

12.5 cm x 7 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk
Shade 002 (cream) 25 g
Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g
3.5 mm Rico hook
Rico stitch markers
Rico tapestry needle

TENSION

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

STOCKING

The stocking is worked beginning with the toe, then the heel, and then up to the top.

Rnd 1: In wine red, 6 dc in a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x around. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnds 6–17: Dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, but leave red yarn attached.

You will pick it back up in round 18.

You will now work the heel of the stocking in turned rows.

Rows 1–6: In cream, dc in next 15 sts, ch 1, turn. 15 sts.

Fasten off, and leaving a long tail, break the yarn. Fold the cream portion of the stocking so that the first and last stitch of row 6 match up. Use yarn tail to sew fold together, forming the heel of the stocking. Weave in end.

Rnd 18: Picking up wine red, dc evenly into the ends of the cream rows, with 2 dc in the first row of cream sts, 1 dc in each additional row and in the corner where the rows meet, and 2 dc in the last row of cream sts. Continue to dc in the unworked wine red stitches from round 17. 30 sts.

Rnds 19–27: 30 dc.

Rnd 28: In cream, in FLO, dc in each st around.

Rnds 29–30: 30 dc.

Ss in the first st of rnd 30. Ch 26, then ss in same first st of the round again. This creates a loop for hanging the stocking. Fasten off, break yarn, and weave in all ends.
